Circa Lighting donates designer lights to Charleston Habitat for Humanity ReStore

Charleston, SC—A true gift in the name of Christmas is the kind that inspires hope, love and prosperity to those in need. It is rare to find and truly a blessing when given. Circa Lighting on King Street is a shining example of a company that gives back to the community, year after year, with a gift that inspires.

Circa Lighting donated \$32,000 worth of merchandise to the Charleston Habitat for Humanity ReStore to help fund our mission of providing affordable housing for working families. Circa Lighting has four stores, two in Georgia, one in Texas and one here in Charleston. All four of the stores donate their excess inventory at the end of each year to a nonprofit. This year they selected Habitat for Humanity and have donated a combined total of \$115,000. Each Habitat affiliate will sell the new, designer lighting at 60-70% off their retail value in their Restores.
